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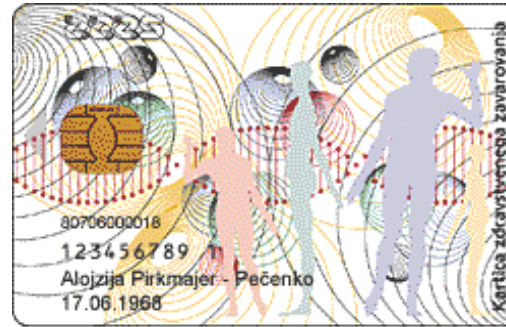
# History of Introducing National Health Insurance Card System

- **1994-1996:** studies, database consolidation and data cleansing, initial system design, cost/benefit analysis (4 years ROI)
- **1998-1999:** Pilot implementation (3% of population, full system functionality)
- **1999-2000:** National implementation



# System Components

- 1.950.000 Health Insurance cards (smartcards, ISO 7816:1-6 compliant)
- 20.000 Health professional cards (key to access data on HIC)
- Card readers (desktop 6630, keyboard integrated 230, portable 890; MCT 0.9 compliant)
- Program libraries
- 300 Self service terminals

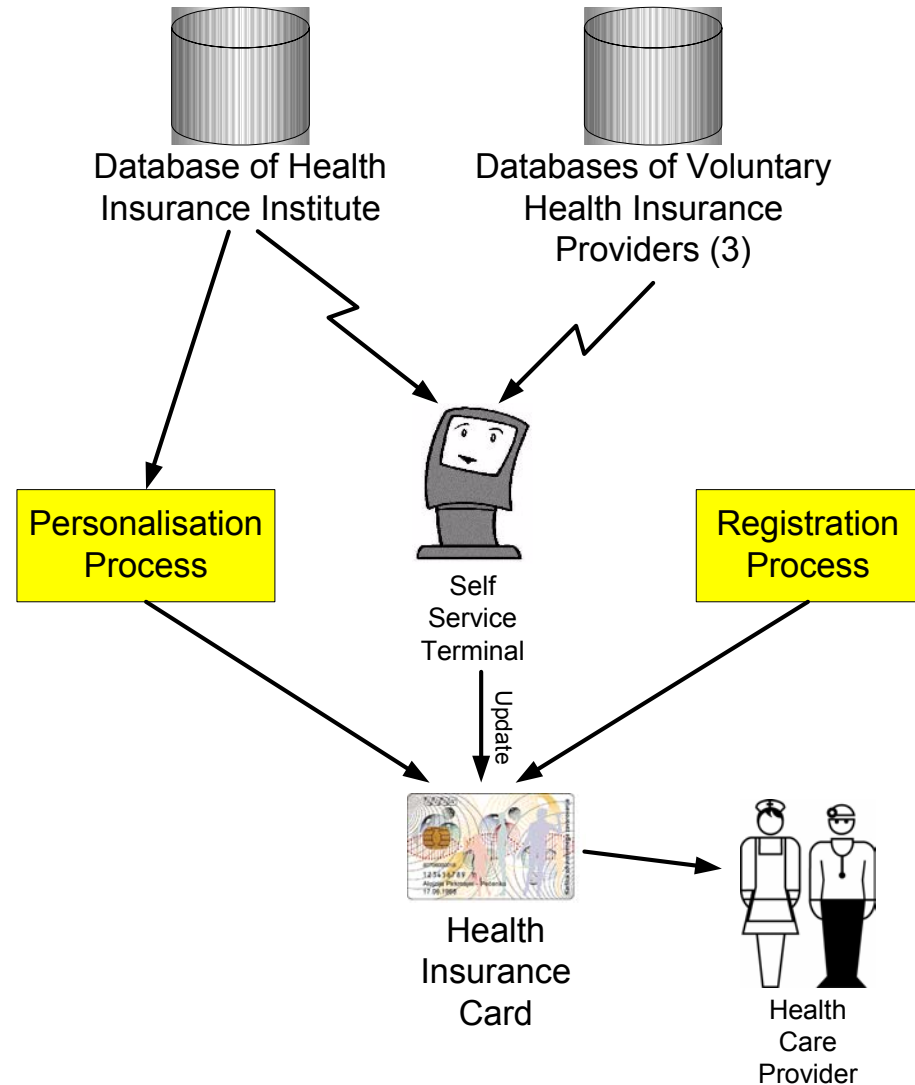

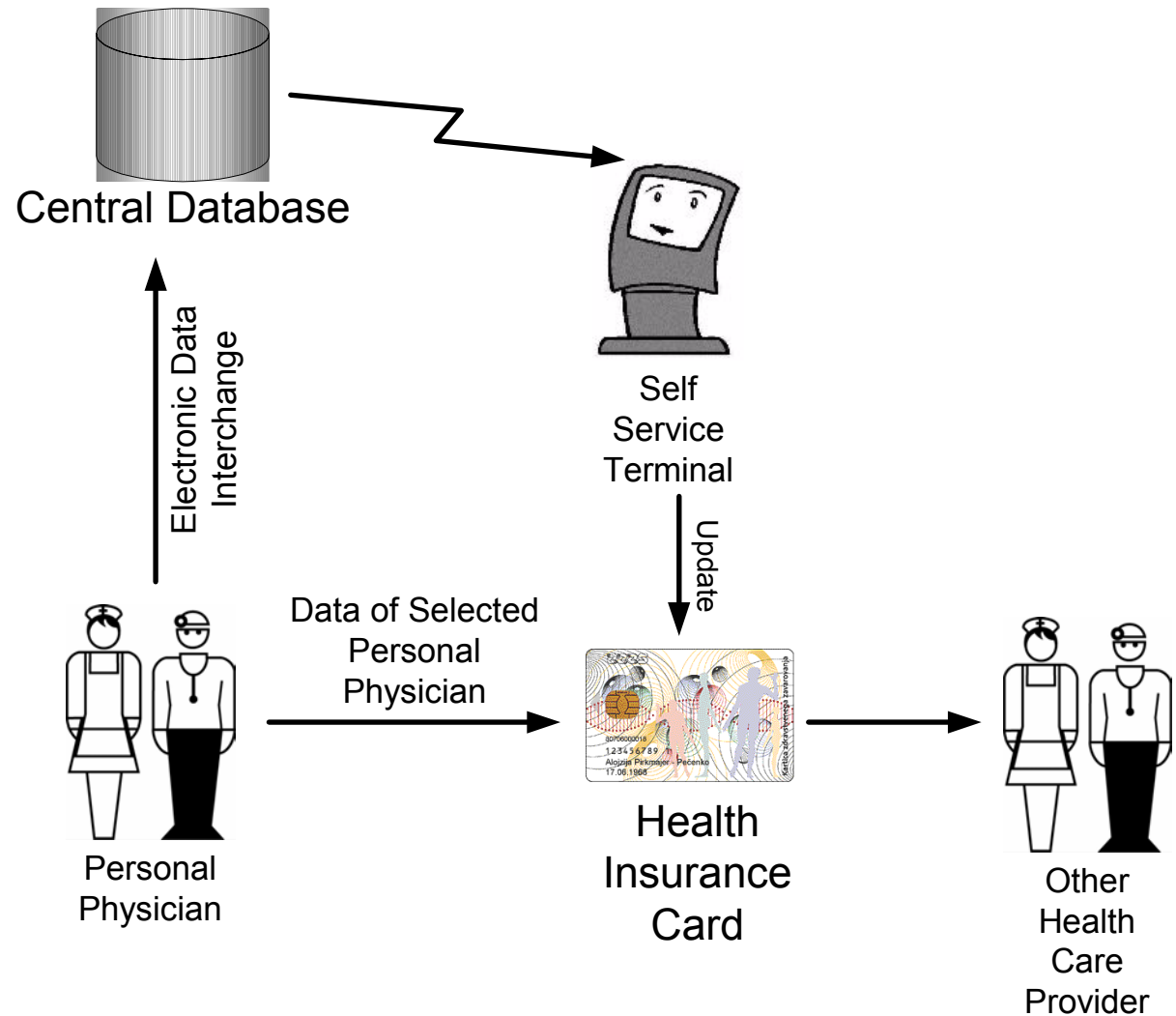

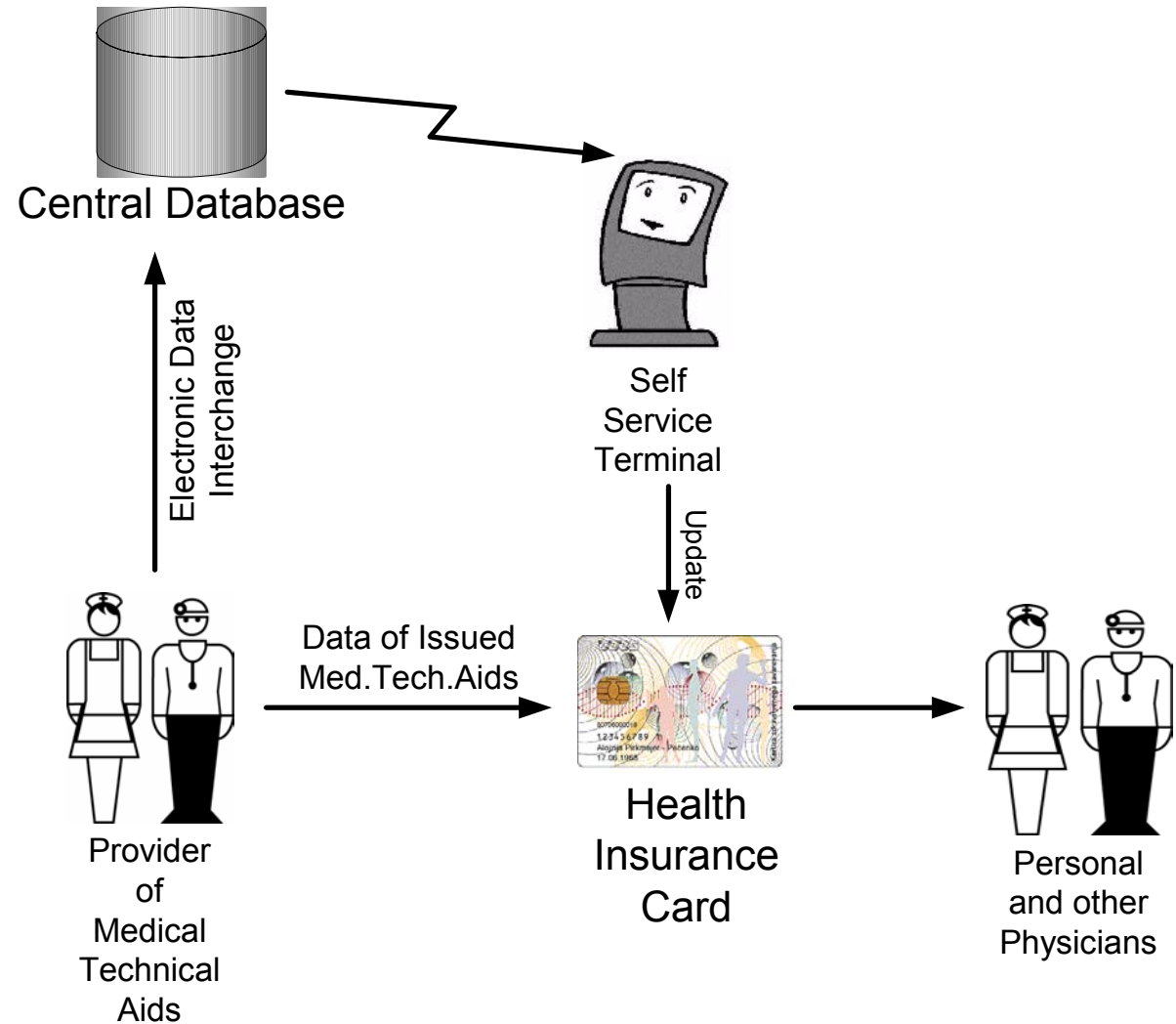

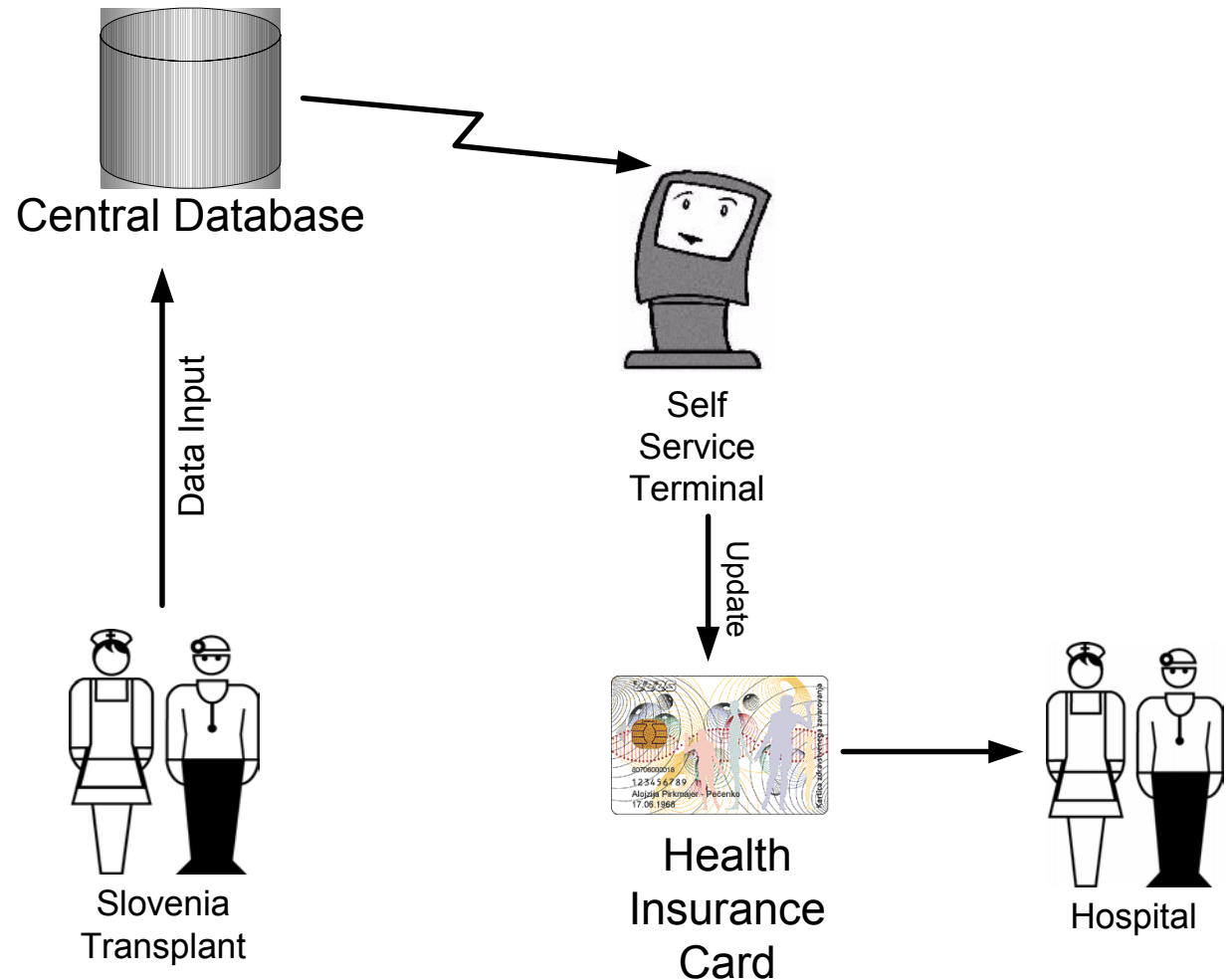

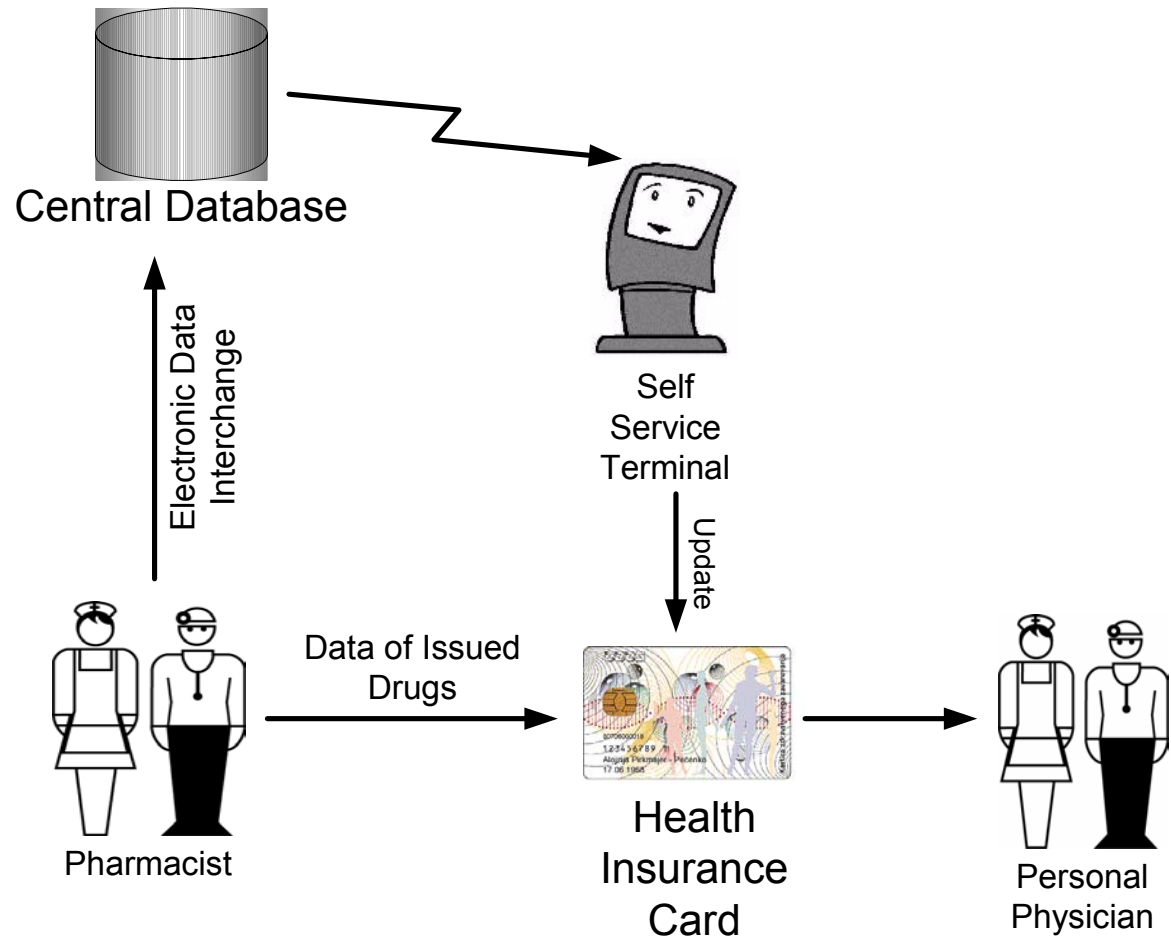

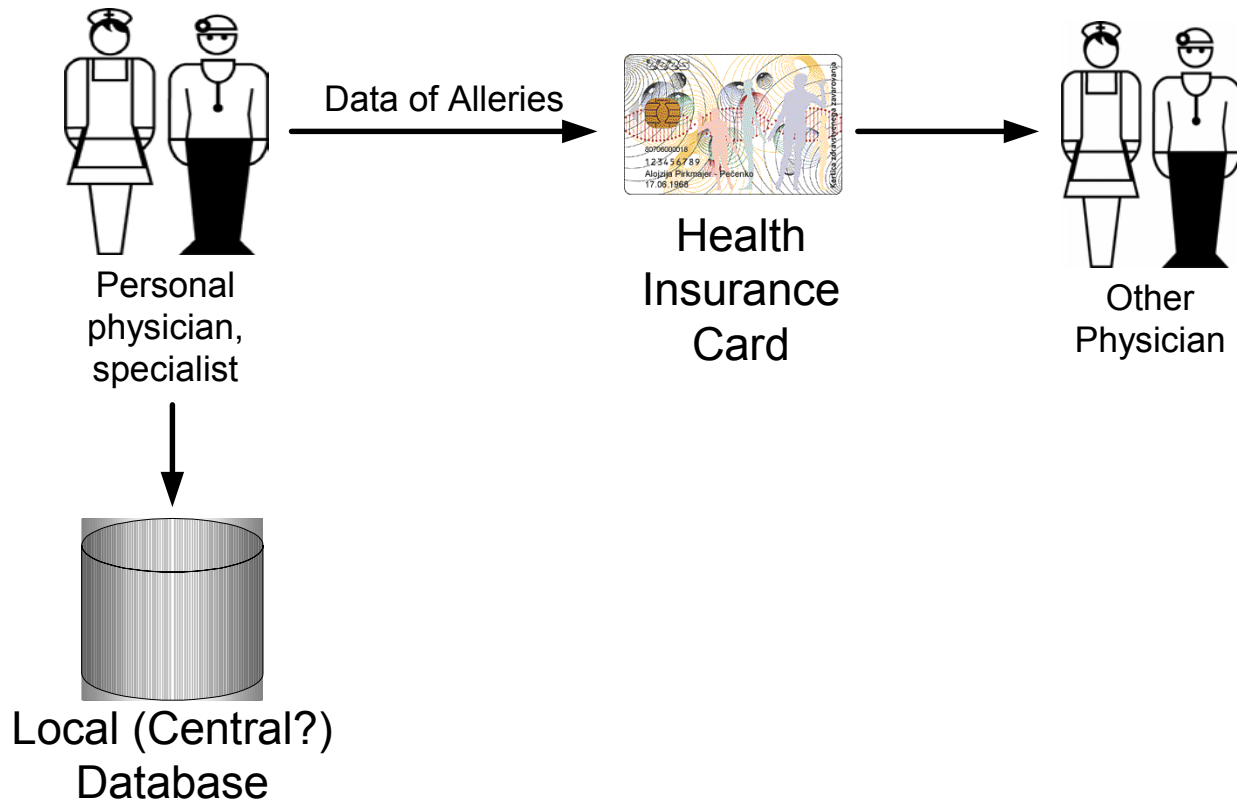

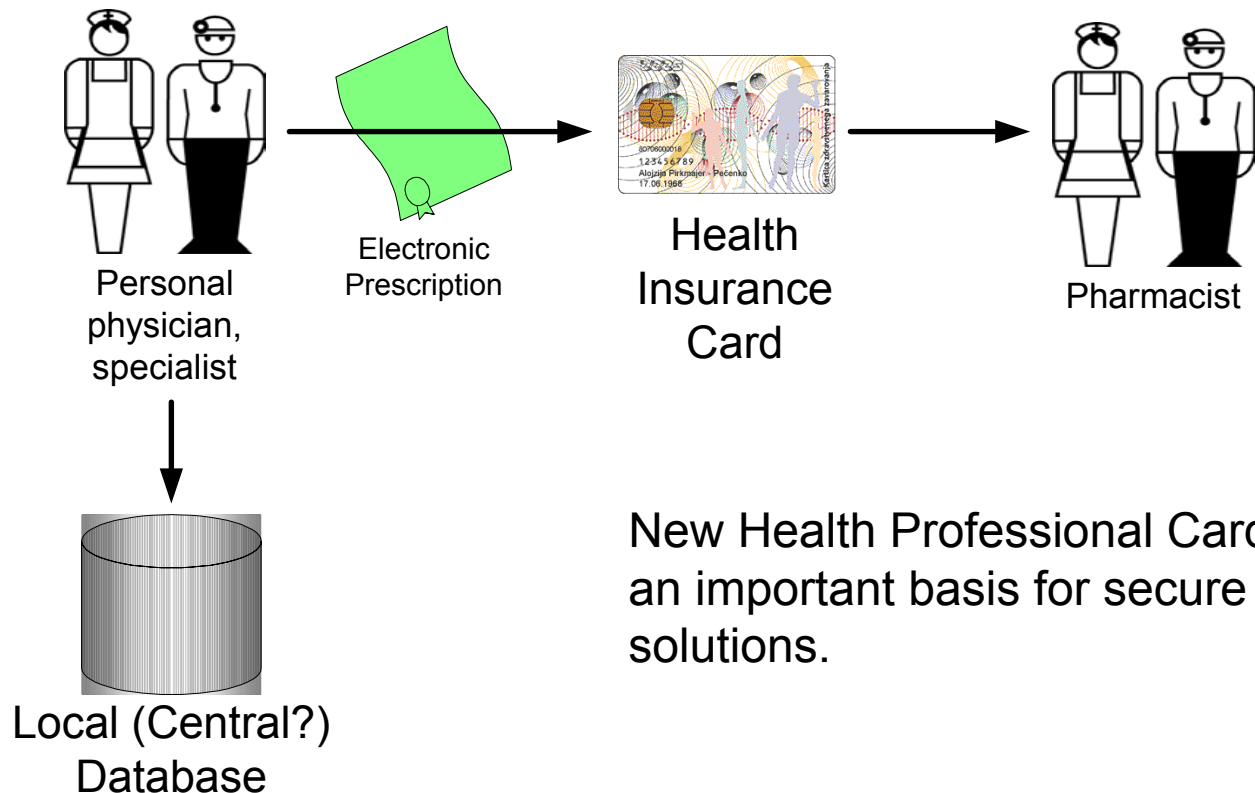
F6: Recording data of allergy to drugs, food, bites of insects and Latex – pilot implementation in June 2005

# System Acceptance

- The Health Insurance Card System was well accepted.
  - Patients: easier and faster access to health services
  - Nurses: faster identification of the patient, less paperwork
  - Physicians: satisfied, but still many of them not using computer (necessary for accessing data on the HIC and for e-prescription)
  - Management of health care providers: less rejections of invoices to insurance companies
  - Insurance Providers: better discipline of payments of premiums



# European Perspective

- Slovenian experts share the experience with colleagues in other countries and contribute to the development of pan-European solutions.
- We take an active part in the Netc@rds project.
- This year preparing a pilot Netc@rds implementation in a Slovenian region:
  - Supporting all 4 Netc@rds scenarios for foreign patients.
  - Enabling scenarios 1 and 4 for slovenian patients using health care services in other countries. The Netc@rds dataset will be added to Slovenian Health Insurance Card.
